\$12,000 Horse Mortality Coverage (Specified Perils) for balance of 2014 \$19.00

Horse(s) you own are insured against death or destruction caused or made necessary by the perils of: fire, lightning, and collision / derailment / overturning of a conveyance in which the horse is being transported, as well as other specified perils described in the policy. The limit per horse / aggregate per member per membership term is \$10,000 regardless of the number or value of horses you own. Claims are settled on an Actual Cash Value basis.

\$12,000 Horse Mortality Coverage (Specified Perils) for 2015 \$27.00

Horse(s) you own are insured against death or destruction caused or made necessary by the perils of: fire, lightning, and collision / derailment / overturning of a conveyance in which the horse is being transported, as well as other specified perils described in the policy.
